Summer Snack

You will need:

- 1 4 oz. package instant pudding mix
- 2 1/2 cups milk
- 10 wooden craft sticks
- 10 3 oz. paper cups
- small colored candies (or crunched M&M's will work)

1. Sprinkle some candies on the bottom of each cup.
2. Combine the pudding mix and the milk in a small mixing bowl with a wire whisk.
3. Spoon pudding into each cup and cover with aluminum foil.
4. Use a knife to make a small hole in the middle of the foil and slide a wooden stick into the hole.
5. Place the cups in the freezer for 4-6 hours. Remove from freezer, tear foil and paper cup off the pudding pops and enjoy!
