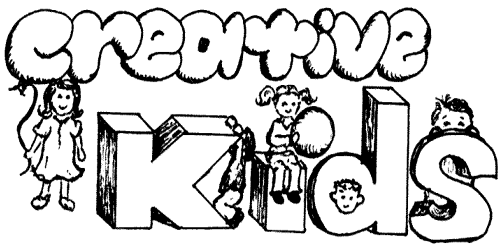
### **St. Therese Parish Presents our 2nd annual FEAST!**

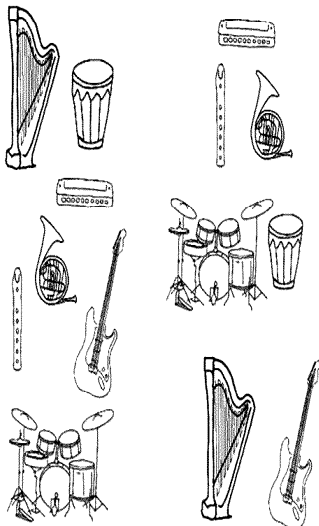


## GOD'S WORD FOR CHILDREN!

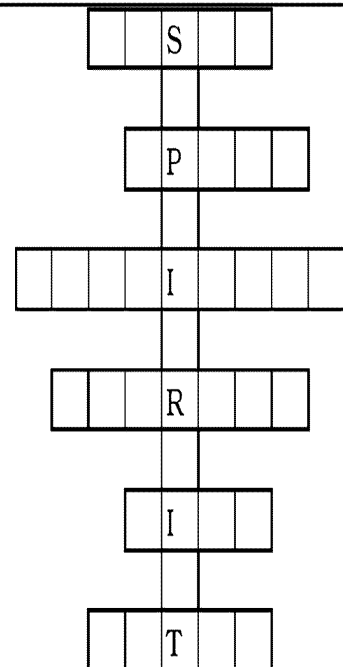
